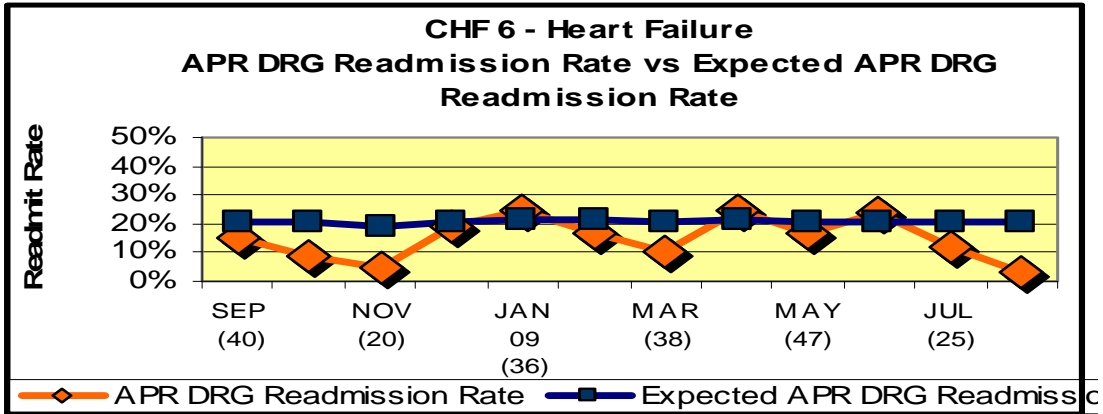

V. Outcomes:

- a. Increased patient satisfaction at end of life August 2008 83.73% to September 2009 99.42%
- b. Positive decrease in mortality O/E from 0.83 to 0.72
- c. No Ventilator Associated Pneumonia for 12 months
- d. Heart Failure readmission less than expected for 9 of 12 months



- e. Postop VTE trending down
