V. Outcomes:

- a. Sustained patient satisfaction at end of life August 2008 83.73% to 99% March 2010
- b. Positive decrease in mortality O/E 0.72 to 0.68 FY09-FY10
- c. Sustained avoidance of Ventilator Associated Pneumonia entire 12 months (total 39 months)
