IV FLUIDS

Sodium Chloride 0.9% + Thiamine 100 mg/L, Folic acid 1 mg/L, and 10 mL of multivitamins/L IV to run at 150 mL/Hr x 1 bag (if not already done in ED), Interrupt current IVF to give then resume current IVF.

MEDICATIONS

CNS medications: For ETOH, BDZ, and opiate withdrawal [Evidence \(14182\)](#)

****For patients > or = 65 years old that can take Po's**

LORazepam (Ativan) Po Tapering Regimen

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg Po TID X 6 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg Po BID X 2 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 0.5 mg Po TID X 3 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 0.5 mg Po BID X 2 doses then discontinue.

Hold LORazepam (Ativan) dose if patient has any of the following symptoms: RR < 10, SBP < 90, PULSE OX < 92%, decreased LOC, or if pt. does not open eyes to voice or tactile stimuli.

****For patients > or = 65 years old that are UNABLE to take Po's**

LORazepam (Ativan) IV Tapering Regimen:

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg IV Push TID X 6 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg IV Push BID X 2 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 0.5 mg IV Push TID X 3 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 0.5 mg IV Push BID X 2 doses then discontinue.

Hold LORazepam (Ativan) dose if patient has any of the following symptoms: RR < 10, SBP < 90, PULSE OX < 92%, decreased LOC, or if pt. does not open eyes to voice or tactile stimuli.

****For patients < 65 years old that can take Po's**

LORazepam (Ativan) Po Tapering Regimen:

LORazepam (Ativan) 2 mg Po TID X 6 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 2 mg Po BID X 2 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg Po TID X 3 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg Po BID X 2 doses then discontinue.

Hold LORazepam (Ativan) dose if patient has any of the following symptoms: RR < 10, SBP < 90, PULSE OX < 92%, decreased LOC, or if pt. does not open eyes to voice or tactile stimuli.

****For patients < 65 years old that are UNABLE to take Po's**

LORazepam (Ativan) IV Tapering Regimen:

LORazepam (Ativan) 2 mg IV Push TID X 6 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 2 mg IV Push BID X 2 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg IV Push TID X 3 doses then,

LORazepam (Ativan) 1 mg IV Push BID X 2 doses then discontinue.

Hold LORazepam (Ativan) dose if patient has any of the following symptoms: RR < 10, SBP < 90, PULSE OX < 92%, decreased LOC, or if pt. does not open eyes to voice or tactile stimuli.

CNS medications: For opiate withdrawal

****For patients > or = 65 years old**

PHENobarbital (Luminal) Tapering Regimen:

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 15 mg Po QID x 8 doses then,

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 15 mg Po TID x 6 doses then,

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 15 mg Po BID x 2 doses then discontinue.

Hold PHENobarbital (Luminal) dose if pt. has decreased LOC or if pt. does not open eyes to voice or tactile stimuli.

****For patients < 65 years old**

PHENobarbital (Luminal) Tapering Regimen:

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 30 mg Po QID x 8 doses then,

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 30 mg Po TID x 3 doses then,

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 15 mg Po TID x 3 doses then,

PHENobarbital (Luminal) 15 mg Po BID x 2 doses then discontinue.

Hold PHENobarbital (Luminal) dose if pt. has decreased LOC or if pt. does not open eyes to voice or tactile stimuli.

CNS medications: For breakthrough withdrawal symptoms

****For patients > or = 65 years old, use 0.5 mg order**

LORazepam (Ativan) 0.5 mg IV Push over 2 mins Q 4 Hrs Prn agitation, diaphoresis, HR > 100, DBP > 100, or SBP > 160. May give IM if no IV access.

****For patients < 65 years old, use 2 mg order**

LORazepam (Ativan) 2 mg IV Push over 2 mins Q 4 Hrs Prn agitation, diaphoresis, HR > 100, DBP > 100, or SBP > 160. May give IM if no IV access.

Cardiac medications: Anti-hypertensives

CloNIDine (Catapres) 0.1 mg Po BID Prn SBP > 160 or DBP > 100.

Cardiac medications: Used for opiate withdrawal *Physician to select **ONE** dose only*

CloNIDine (Catapres) 0.1 mg Po TID

CloNIDine (Catapres TTS -1) 0.1 mg/24 Hrs patch. Apply topically Q 7 Days.

CloNIDine (Catapres TTS -2) 0.2 mg/24 Hrs patch. Apply topically Q 7 Days.

CloNIDine (Catapres TTS -3) 0.3 mg/24 Hrs patch. Apply topically Q 7 Days.

Cardiac medications: Beta Blockers *Physician to select **ONE** drug only*

Metoprolol tartrate (Lopressor) 25 mg Po BID. Hold for SBP < 100.

Propranolol (Inderal) 10 mg Po TID. Hold for SBP < 100.

GI medications: Anti-emetics

Ondansetron (Zofran) 4 mg IV Push Q 12 Hrs Prn N&V. If ineffective after 30 mins, give proCHLORperazine (if ordered). May give IM if no IV access.

ProCHLORperazine (Compazine) 10 mg IV Push Q 6 Hrs Prn N&V. If ondansetron Prn is also ordered, give ondansetron first. If ondansetron ineffective after 30 mins, give proCHLORperazine as ordered. May give IM if no IV access.

Metoclopramide (Reglan) 10 mg IV Push Q 6 Hrs Prn N&V. If ondansetron and proCHLORperazine Prn are also ordered, give ondansetron first. If ondansetron ineffective after 30 mins, give proCHLORperazine as ordered. If proCHLORperazine ineffective after 30 mins, give metoclopramide as ordered. May give IM if no IV access.

Other medications

REMINDER: The folic acid, thiamine, and MVI orders below are defaulted to start in AM tomorrow, physician to use the edit button to alter start date and time if needed.

Magnesium sulfate 2 Gm/50 mL premixed bag IVPB Prn Magnesium level < 1.8 mg/dL

Folic Acid 1 mg Po daily start tomorrow

Thiamine 100 mg Po daily start tomorrow

Multivitamin with minerals (Theragram M) 1 Tab Po daily start tomorrow
